How to Lease Off-Campus Spaces Needed for **University Departments**

In accordance to University Policy 5400, Virginia Tech departments wishing to lease spaces off campus including storage/warehouse and residential space not covered by the university travel policy may submit a space request via their space representative to the Office of University Planning online. Upon approval of the space request, Real Estate Management will collaborate with the department to identify appropriate space and assist in the leasing process. Important Notice Regarding Thermo Fisher Scientific Chemicals Inc

Where to go to get help with Customs or Import Goods Issues?

Virginia Tech has a customs broker who can assist any department or unit at the university with customs or import of goods issues. Don't try to handle customs-related issues on your own. AirSchott Inc is the University's partner and has the legal capacity to represent the university in assisting with customs and import issues of goods. Electron-Beam Lithography System

Procurement recently helped the Bradley Department of Electrical and Computer Engineering to procure an Electron-beam Lithography (EBL) System.

This system utilizes a focused beam of electrons in order to draw custom shapes on a surface covered with an electron-sensitive film called a resist. This specific EBL System was purchased from JEOL USA, INC. and is nearly twice as strong as competing EBL systems. This will be the first EBL systems of its kind in North America, with only two others currently in existence in the world. This system will be house at the Virginia Tech Corporate Research Center, located in Blacksburg, VA.
