


Amazon Business Office Items List

Helpful Tips When Purchasing Slack

Slack is a chat-based communication tool used by teams for online collaboration. The Division of IT hosts an official Virginia Tech Slack Workspace for the university at virginiatech.slack.com. More details about Slack can be found here.

Helpful tips when purchasing Slack

- Should be purchased through an ISR to the supplier VT Departmental Software
- Along with the Software Order Form, please attach an Excel spreadsheet indicating the PID(s) to which each license should be assigned, to the HokieMart order.
- A PID and an active university affiliation is needed to be able to purchase a Slack license through VT Departmental Software. Along with this Slack has not been reviewed for student use, so students can't purchase a license
- Once your order has been processed these PID(s) will have immediate access to Slack

P-cards Move To **Electronic Statements** Starting September

We are excited to announce that Virginia Tech is moving to electronic statements for all Pcard holders, effective September 16th. This change aligns with our commitment to sustainability and environmental responsibility as part of our ongoing green initiatives.

By transitioning to electronic statements, we aim to reduce paper waste, lower our carbon footprint, and streamline the statement review process for cardholders. Each month, you will be responsible for logging into Bank of America's Global Card Access to review your statements and reconcile them in Chrome River by the 10th of the month.

This change ensures faster and more secure access to your account information while allowing you to manage your expenses efficiently. We appreciate your cooperation and support in helping us positively impact the environment.



New Payment Category for Payment Request Forms

Please note that a new category for Non PO Payment Request Forms has been added and is now available for immediate use.

E11- Research Project Participants (Subjects) **DETAILS:**

Limited to purchases less that \$500 in total value. Incentives paid to individuals for participation in research. Requires Institutional Review Board (IRB) approval and attachment to form. When such payments are made, the disbursements are handled as payments to independent contractors, not payments to employees for work performed. Appropriate IRS form (W9, W-8BEN) required for any payment exceeding \$75. See Procedure 23715c: Selecting and Paying Human Subject Participants for additional information.
